Students entering the BSN program will be eligible to sit for the national licensure exam (NCLEX-PN), and can work as LPNs while completing their final year of the BSN.

Graduates successfully

completing the BSN program will be eligible to apply for licensure as registered nurses with state boards of nursing.

## About the Program

In S-DCs Nursing Program:

- Students learn from professionals still working in the profession who know what employers want.
